

Steps to Making the Butcher's Apron

Directions: Below are the Steps for Making the Butcher's Apron. Your job is to record the date you started the step and the date you completed the step. Part of your evaluation grade will be based on "staying on task" while working on the Butcher's Apron. Ms. Black must initial the completed date confirming you have completed the step properly.

Step	Date Started	Date Completed
1. Pressing Fabric, if needed		
2. Straighten Crosswise Grains for Ties		
3. Cut out Ties		
4. Pin Pattern to Fabric		
5. Cut out Apron		
6. Top Hem of Apron – Pin 2 inches & Press		
Repin fold in half & Repress		
Sew Top hem down (approx. ¾ in) use side of foot		
Bottom Hem of Apron - Pin 2 inches & Press		
Repin fold in half & Repress		
Sew bottom hem down (same as # 6)		
7. Side of Aprons – Pin 1 inch & Press (do both sides)		
Repin fold in half & Repress		
Sew side hems down (approx. 3/8 in.) use side of foot		
8. Mitering Corners for Ties – Fold and press		
Cut both tie ends		
9. Pin ties together		
Sew Ties together		
10. Fold, Pin & press Ties to Create Self-bias		
Refold, repin & repress ties in half		
11. Find Center Neck loop and Placement of Apron		
12. Pin Ties to Apron		
13. Sew Ties (¾ inch or 7/8 inch) use side of foot		
14. Apron Evaluation Self
