

Simple Square Pincushion Project

Supplies:

1 - 5x5 inch square scrap fabric

1 button

1 - 5x5 inch square felt

10 grams of fiber-fill

7 ½ inches of ribbon or self-fabric

Project directions: As each step is completed by you, have Ms. Black initial on the line in front of that step.

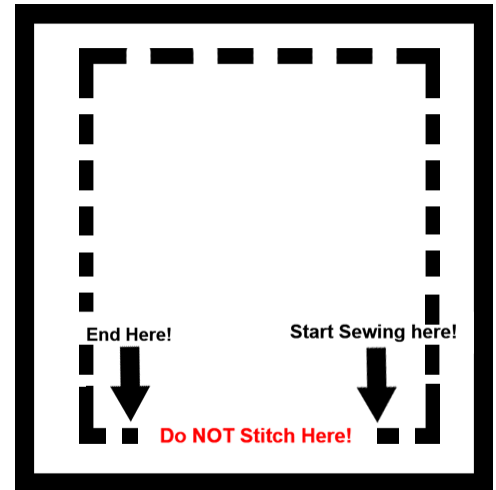
_____ Step 1: Very lightly mark ½ inch sewing lines on felt.

_____ Step 2: In the center of the scrap fabric, hand sew button.

_____ Step 3: Fold ribbon in ½ and sew to right side of fabric about a sewing machine foot away from edge.

_____ Step 4: Pin fabric to felt square, RIGHT sides together!

_____ Step 5: Using the “marked” sewing lines, sew the two squares together leaving about a 3-inch opening as shown on the right. →



✓ PIVOT at the corners!

✓ Don't FORGET to backstitch at the beginning and end of the sewing/seam line or you will have to hand tie the threads together!

_____ Step 6: Carefully clip corners to reduce bulk.

_____ Step 7: Flip right side out!

_____ Step 8: Using the corner tool, carefully manipulate corners so that they are “pointy”.

_____ Step 9: Fill with the 10 grams of fiber-fill.

_____ Step 10: Hand sew the opening closed using thread that matches the fabric.

_____ Step 11: (Optional step) Re-sew the button tightly so that your pincushion has an indentation where the button is.
