Intro (pick -- see pg 2 for picking pattern):

Em C G D (x2)

Verse 1 (pick):

Em C G D Em C G D  
So your standing in the middle of a thunder and lighting  
Em C G D Em C G D  
And I know your feeling like you just can't win but your trying  
*(strum each chord SOFTLY)*  
C C D D  
Its hard to keep on keepin on when your bein pushed around(pushes a-round)  
C C D D  
Dont even know which way is up, you just keep spinning down around down

\*Chorus (strum):

Em C G D  
Every storm runs, runs out of rain  
Em C G D  
Just like every dark night turns into day  
Em C G D  
Every heartache will fade away  
Em C G D  
Just like every storm runs, runs out of rain

(pick):

Em C G D (x2) Repeat x4 after Verse 2

Verse 2 (pick):

Em C G D Em  
So hold your head up and tell yourself that theres something more and  
C G D  
walk out that door  
Em C G D Em C G D  
Go find a new rose, don't be afraid of the thorns cause we all have thorns

*(strum each chord SOFTLY)*

C C D D  
Just put your feet up to the edge put your face in the wind  
C C D D  
And when you fall back down, keep on rememberin

**Bridge (strum down):**

**C**

It's gonna run out of pain

**Em**

It's gonna run out of sting

**C**

It's gonna leave you alone

**D** (tacet = stop chord)

It's gonna set you free

(pick): **Em C G D (x2)**

and set you free.

**Final Chorus (strum):**

**Em C G D**

Every storm runs, runs out of rain

**Em C G D**

Just like every dark night turns into day

**Em C G D**

Every heartache will fade away

**Em C G D**

Just like every storm runs, runs out of rain

(pick):

**Em C G D Em C G D**

It's gonna set you free

**Em C G D Em C G**

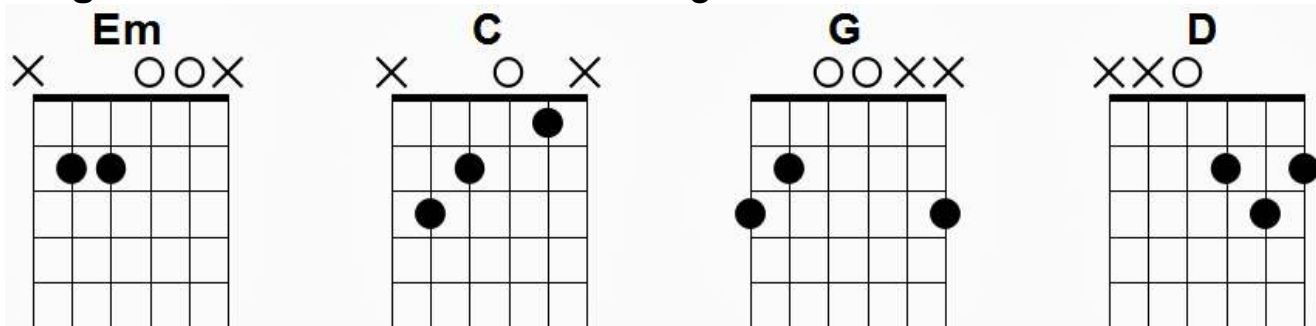
It's gonna run out o' pain
